Free forming the approach of the ADA approach ramp has proven a difficult task for even the most skilled mason, and often requires multiple attempts to meet the government's stringent specification; a shallow gutter and slope that allows for only a ½" rise over a span of 24".

Action:

Fabrication/technical challenges presented were addressed by trial and error prototyping and multiple design revisions. After many attempts a repeatable bending protocol was developed to yield the required tool profile.

Result:

dee has successfully developed a solution tool to meet the challenge posed by hand forming the street side of approach of the ADA approach ramp.


